heretofore, that before the filing of this complaint, that Michael J. Krusee, on or about the 30 day of April, 2008, in Austin, Williamson County, Texas, did then knowingly and intentionally operate a motor vehicle while intoxicated upon a public roadway in the said County and State, to wit: Anderson Mill, eastbound from US 183.. At the time he/she operated the motor alcohol, a controlled substance, a drug, a dangerous drug, a combination of two or more of those substances, or any other substance into his/her body.

Probable cause for arrest was based on the following facts:

On Wednesday, April 30, 2008 at approximately 10:13pm I was on patrol and traveling east on Anderson Mill Road from US 183. As I crossed under US 183 on Anderson Mill Road I observed a black, BMW bearing TXLP# SO-113 in the right turn lane of the northbound frontage road of US 183. The vehicle made a right turn from US 183 and proceeded east on Anderson Mill Road in the outside lane. As I followed the vehicle and we approached Pond Springs I observed that the vehicle was weaving from one side of its lane to the other. I got closer to the vehicle and observed that the license plate showed to have expired in December 2007. I ran the plate through DPS Austin Communications and we proceeded east on Anderson Mill Road. After the vehicle turned left onto Black Oak, DPS Communications confirmed that the plate had expired in December 2007. I turned after the vehicle and caught up to it at Black Oak and Briar Hollow and initiated a traffic stop for Display Expired Registration. We came to a stop in approximately the 13000 block of Briar Hollow. I approached the vehicle, identified myself to the driver, advised him of the reason for the stop and asked to see his driver license and insurance. As I stood at the door of the vehicle I observed the strong odor of a metabolized alcoholic beverage. I also observed that the driver's eyes were red and watery and his eyelids were droopy. I asked the driver: KRUSEE, Michael, W/M, DOB 02/26/59, to step out of and to the rear of the vehicle. As I spoke with KRUSEE I observed that there was the strong odor of a metabolized alcoholic beverage on his breath and he swayed as he stood. I asked KRUSEE how much he had to drink and he told me that he had one glass of wine.

After determining that KRUSEE was a candidate I administered Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFST's) and he exhibited sufficient clues to indicate intoxication. Based on my observations of KRUSEE and his performance on the SFST' iı u ir

ntroduction of an alcoholic beverage into his system and was, therefore, intoxicated. I advised KRUSEE that he was inder arrest for Driving While Intoxicated (DWI), advised him of his Miranda Rights, placed him in handcuffs and into the front seat of my patrol car.
read KRUSEE a DIC-24 Statutory Warning at the scene and he refused to submit to a breath or blood test and also efused to answer any questions. I then transported and booked KRUSEE into the Williamson County jail for DWI.
