NEW LAW 12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-226 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 13 No state, county, municipal or political subdivision may 14 15 contract with any private corporation to provide for the use of any photo monitoring device to detect any red light violation. 16 As used in this section, the term "photo monitoring device" 17 В. means a stationary, unmanned device used with a lighted traffic 18 control device to detect a red light violation combined with a 19 photographic identification of the vehicle which results in the 20 issuance of a citation against the registrant, rather than the 21 driver, of the vehicle. 22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019. 23
